

# MECHANICAL ENGINEERING, DOCTORAL MINOR

## REQUIREMENTS

### REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete the following requirements to earn a doctoral minor:

1. Complete at least nine credits in courses numbered 400 or above in Mechanical Engineering (M E ([https://guide.wisc.edu/courses/m\\_e/](https://guide.wisc.edu/courses/m_e/))).
  - a. Research, independent study and seminar courses may not satisfy requirements.
2. At least one course (three credits) must be numbered 700 or above in Mechanical Engineering (M E ([https://guide.wisc.edu/courses/m\\_e/](https://guide.wisc.edu/courses/m_e/))).
3. Only one course may be cross-listed with the student's major department.
4. Earn a minimum grade of B or higher in all courses taken for the minor.
5. Grades of BC and below are not accepted.

### PRIOR COURSEWORK

Up to six credits of graduate credits earned at other institutions may satisfy requirements.
