HOW TO GET IN

Qualified high school juniors and seniors who intend to pursue admission as University Special students must review and complete the required application steps on the ACSSS website (<https://acsss.wisc.edu/high-school/>).

A minimum high school GPA of 3.000 overall and in the most recent semester is required. Additional requirements include recommendations from high school personnel and academic qualification for the course(s) of interest.

Before applying, interested students should review the details regarding the options for high school students are provided on the ACSSS website (<https://acsss.wisc.edu/high-school/>) and meet with their high school guidance counselor to determine if taking a university course is a sound academic choice.
