PROSPECTIVE UW-MADISON STUDENTS

All prospective UW-Madison students must apply through the Office of Admissions and Recruitment (<https://www.admissions.wisc.edu/>).

Students interested in this major should select it as the first choice major on their UW-Madison application. Admitted students who enroll at UW-Madison and attend Student Orientation, Advising, and Registration (SOAR) with the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences have the option to declare this major at SOAR. Students who intend to major in Biochemistry may not combine this major ("double major") with the Molecular and Cell Biology major.

The Biochemistry major is offered through either the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences (CALs) or the College of Letters & Science (L&S). Students interested in the differences or transferring between CALs and L&S should meet with the advisor to discuss this in more detail.
