HOW TO GET IN

All current UW-Madison undergraduates and University Special Students are eligible to complete the Certificate in Educational Policy Studies. Students must complete at least one Educational Policy Studies (ED POL) (https://guide.wisc.edu/courses/ed_pol/) course with a grade of B or better prior to declaring the certificate program. Students intending to complete the Educational Policy Studies Certificate should visit the School of Education's Certificate Programs (<https://education.wisc.edu/academics/certificates/>) page to complete the declaration form.

Students pursuing the Educational Policy Studies major, the Certificate in International Development and Education, the Certificate in Global Cultures, Languages, and Education, and/or the Certificate in Social Justice and Education, are not eligible to complete the Educational Policy Studies certificate.
