Admissions to the Technical Communication, Certificate have been suspended as of fall 2025 and will be discontinued as of fall 2027. If you have any questions, please contact the department.

Undergraduates who would like to enroll in the Technical Communication Certificate (TCC) may download the TCC Application form (PDF) (<https://tc.engr.wisc.edu/certificate/applying-to-the-technical-communication-certificate/>). Email the completed TCC Application along with a PDF of your current DARS report to Laura Grossenbacher, Director of the Tech Comm Program, at lrgrossenbac@wisc.edu. Graduate students and non-degree-seeking students cannot enroll in the TCC.

PREREQUISITES FOR ADMISSION TO THE TCC PROGRAM

- A grade of at least B in Communication A or equivalent course or AP English credits (score of at least 4 out of 5).
- Four courses (12-credit minimum) in science and/or engineering, including at least one intermediate-level (minimum 200-level) course.
- Three courses (9-credit minimum) in humanities, social sciences, and/or foreign language.
- Overall GPA of at least 2.5.

Applications are accepted throughout the semester, though students are encouraged to submit applications as early as possible so they have ample time to plan their coursework. The program will notify all new admissions via email.
