

CHICANA/O AND LATINA/O STUDIES, CERTIFICATE

The Chicana/o and Latina/o Studies undergraduate certificate is being renamed Chicanx/e and Latinx/e Studies. Students will be able to earn a Certificate in Chicana/o and Latina/o Studies through the end of Summer 2027. Beginning in Fall 2027, the program awarded will be the Certificate in Chicanx/e and Latinx/e Studies.

The certificate in Chicana/o and Latina/o Studies offers a systematic and interdisciplinary analysis of Mexican- and Latin-American-origin people, cultures, and collectivities within the United States. The Chicana/o and Latina/o Studies certificate is designed to provide students with a broad knowledge base and the intellectual tools to understand the unity and diversity of U.S. Latinx/e populations. The primary objective of the certificate is to train students in the study of Chicana/o and Latina/o Studies, as well as to introduce them to the central questions, topics, and applications that have emerged in this field of inquiry.
