

SOUTHEAST ASIAN STUDIES, CERTIFICATE

The Southeast Asian Studies certificate meets the needs of students choosing to focus on the Southeast Asia region—Brunei, Cambodia, East Timor, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar/Burma, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam—but not wishing to commit to the more rigorous language and area studies courses required for the Asian Languages and Cultures major. Students select classes reflecting their interests offered through many university departments and can work toward a variety of undergraduate majors. The certificate is of value to students wishing to demonstrate their knowledge of the Southeast Asian region either to potential employers or to graduate schools.
