HOW TO GET IN

To declare a certificate in physics, students must fill out a major/certificate declaration form. An undergraduate physics advisor must sign the form.

The form to declare the certificate can be obtained at the Physics departmental office. All undergraduate students are eligible to declare the certificate, except those declared in the following majors:

- Physics,
- Astronomy-Physics, and
- Applied Mathematics, Engineering, and Physics (AMEP)
